11.2 WORDS AND TERMS

11.2.1 Definitions. The following specific words and terms are defined as follows:

Agricultural: Currently in use for farm or ranch purposes, including pasture and assessed in the Archuleta County Assessor's records as agricultural land.

Agricultural Uses: Those farm or ranch uses which primarily involve raising, harvesting, producing or keeping plants or animals, including agricultural structures which house farm or ranch implements, hay, grain, poultry, livestock or other horticultural products. An agricultural structure shall not be a place of human habitation. Agricultural uses exclude any business whose primary function is to provide on-site services or retail sales of non-agricultural products. Agricultural Uses excludes any use governed by the Colorado ~~Marijuana Regulation in Articles 10-12 and Natural Medicine Regulations in Article 50 of Title 44. Medical Marijuana Program (CRS §25-1.5-106 et seq), Colorado Medical Marijuana Code (CRS §12-43.3-101 et seq), or Colorado Retail Marijuana Code (CRS §12-43.4-101 et seq).~~

Kitchen, Residential: An area in a residential dwelling or dwelling unit used to prepare food that contains all of the following elements: 1. kitchen sink (larger than 12" x 12"), 2. refrigeration, 3. cooking appliances (microwaves and counter-top appliances are exempt). If any one of these elements is not present, it is not considered a residential kitchen. *See also Kitchenette and Commercial Kitchen.*

Kitchen, Commercial: The portion of a building used for the preparing of food in large quantities, for use in restaurants, hotels, catering, food manufacturing, and similar uses.

Kitchenette: An area in a residential building used to prepare food that does not contain all of the elements of a Residential Kitchen.

Marijuana: As defined by the Colorado Constitution, all parts of the plant of the genus cannabis whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted from any part of the plant, and every compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its seeds, or its resin, including marihuana concentrate; does not include Industrial Hemp.

Medical Marijuana Caregiver: A person, other than a medical patient or the patient's physician, who is 18 years of age or older and has significant responsibility for managing the well-being of a patient who has a debilitating medical condition, as defined by CRS §25-1.5-106(2)(d.5).

Medical Marijuana Establishment: Means a medical marijuana center, medical marijuana-infused products manufacturer, and/or optional premises cultivation operation licensed pursuant to the Archuleta County Marijuana Licensing Regulations as amended from time to time.

Natural Medicine: Includes natural forms of psilocybin, psilocin, dimethyltryptamine, ibogaine, mescaline, not including synthetic or synthetic analogs of these substances, and not including peyote pursuant to C.R.S. 44-50-103(13). *See also Regulated Natural Medicine.*

Natural Medicine Business: Any of the following entities licensed pursuant to the Colorado Natural Medicine Code (C.R.S. Title 44, Article 50):

- i. Natural Medicine Healing Center – A facility where an entity is authorized to provide and supervise Natural Medicine Services for a participant.
- ii. Natural Medicine Cultivation Facility – A location where Regulated Natural Medicine is grown, harvested, and prepared for transfer and distribution to either a Natural Medicine Healing Center, Natural Medicine Facilitator, a Natural Medicine Products Manufacturer, or to another Natural Medicine Cultivation Facility.
- iii. Natural Medicine Product Manufacturer – A person who manufactures Regulated Natural Medicine Products for transfer to a Natural Medicine Healing Center, Natural Medicine Facilitator, or to another Natural Medicine Products Manufacturer.
- iv. Natural Medicine Testing Facility – A public or private laboratory licensed, or approved by the Division, to perform testing and research on Regulated Natural Medicine and Regulated Natural Medicine Product.

Natural Medicine Facilitator: A person who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older, has the necessary qualifications, training, experience, and knowledge to perform and supervise natural medicine services for a participant, and is licensed to engage in the practice of facilitation by the director of the Division of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies pursuant to Article 170 of Title 12.

Natural Medicine Product: A product infused with Natural Medicine that is intended for consumption.

Natural Medicine Services: The following are considered Natural Medicine Services and must be conducted in a licensed Natural Medicine Healing Center:

- i. Preparation Session – a meeting between a participant and a Natural Medicine Facilitator that occurs before an administration session, not including an initial consultation or inquiry;
- ii. Administration Session – a session conducted at a Natural Medicine Healing Center during which a participant consumes and experiences the effects of natural medicine under the supervision of a Natural Medicine Facilitator;
- iii. Integration Session – a meeting between a participant and a Natural Medicine Facilitator that occurs after the completion of an administration session.

Regulated Natural Medicine: Natural Medicine that is cultivated, manufactured, tested, stored, distributed, transported, transferred, or dispensed pursuant to Article 50 of Title 44.

Retail Marijuana Establishment: Means a retail marijuana center, and/or retail marijuana cultivation facility licensed pursuant to the Archuleta County Marijuana Licensing Regulations as amended from time to time.
